Therefore the following guidelines will apply during all *JGFA* related activities.

I understand the following will **NOT** be tolerated:

- ◆ Conduct detrimental to the *JGFA*, *Golf Professional Services, Inc* and all participating facilities including abuse of club facilities
- ◆ Use of alcohol or illegal drugs
- ◆ Gambling
- ◆ Abusive language or profanity
- ◆ Displays of temper involving throwing or slamming bags, balls, clubs or other equipment
- ◆ Cheating
- ◆ Poor golf etiquette
- ◆ Breach of the USGA rules of golf

Any breach of the above guidelines on conduct will result in:

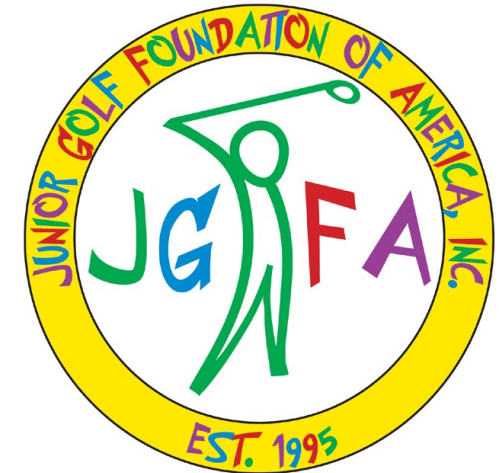
